

PROJECT OF HUMANITARIAN IDENTIFICATION OF VIOLATED AND MISSING PERSONS IN THE DISTRICT OF CHUNGUI, IN PERU

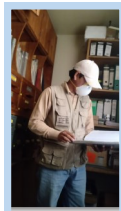
Objectives:

Carry out multidisciplinary and interdisciplinary research consisting of locating the victims' relatives to find out the circumstances of the event, recording *ante mortem* information and taking reference sample to identify the human remains of the Chungui case.

Methodology:

Diagnosis:

The team diagnosed 125 victims pending identification in 13 communities of Chungui



Field work:

The team went to the communities, recorded *antemortem* data of the relatives and extracted reference samples



Identification:

The experts compared and evaluated the information to identify the human remains recovered.



Results and products:

The details of the violent events that occurred in Chungui and in the Oreja de Perro area have been reconstructed.

A total of 240 dead and missing persons have been counted in Chungui, in relation to 10 cases of fiscal investigation, of which 149 bodies have been recovered and 46 bodies have been identified by anthropological-forensic and molecular biology methods. It has not been possible to identify 103 persons due to the absence of detailed information.

In the course of the project, 63 *antemortem* files were registered with the individualizing data of the deceased and missing persons. A total of 87 reference samples were obtained.
