Results of Examination

BCSO-1, BCSO-2, BCSO-3, and BCSO-4 were physically and chemically processed.

No latent prints were recovered from BCSO-1 and BCSO-4.

Photographs of possible latent prints were captured of BCSO-2 (BCSO-2.1) and BCSO-3 (BCSO-3.3 and BCSO-3.4).

BCSO-2.1, BCSO-3.3, and BCSO-3.4 were visually examined.

One (1) latent fingerprint on BCSO-2.1 was determined to be of value for comparison purposes. BCSO-2.1 was compared to Gerald Gillespie (BCSO-8) and was excluded as originating from the same source. BCSO-2.1 was searched through the Automated Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS) and identified as the right thumb of Ryan Gillespie (DOB: 11/28/1982, SID #: ABC293881).

BCSO-3.3 and BCSO-3.4 were determined to contain latent impressions of insufficient value for comparison purposes.
